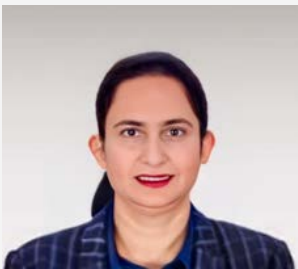

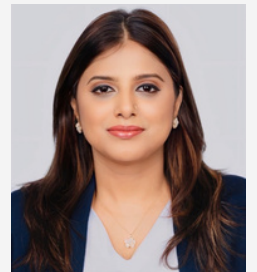

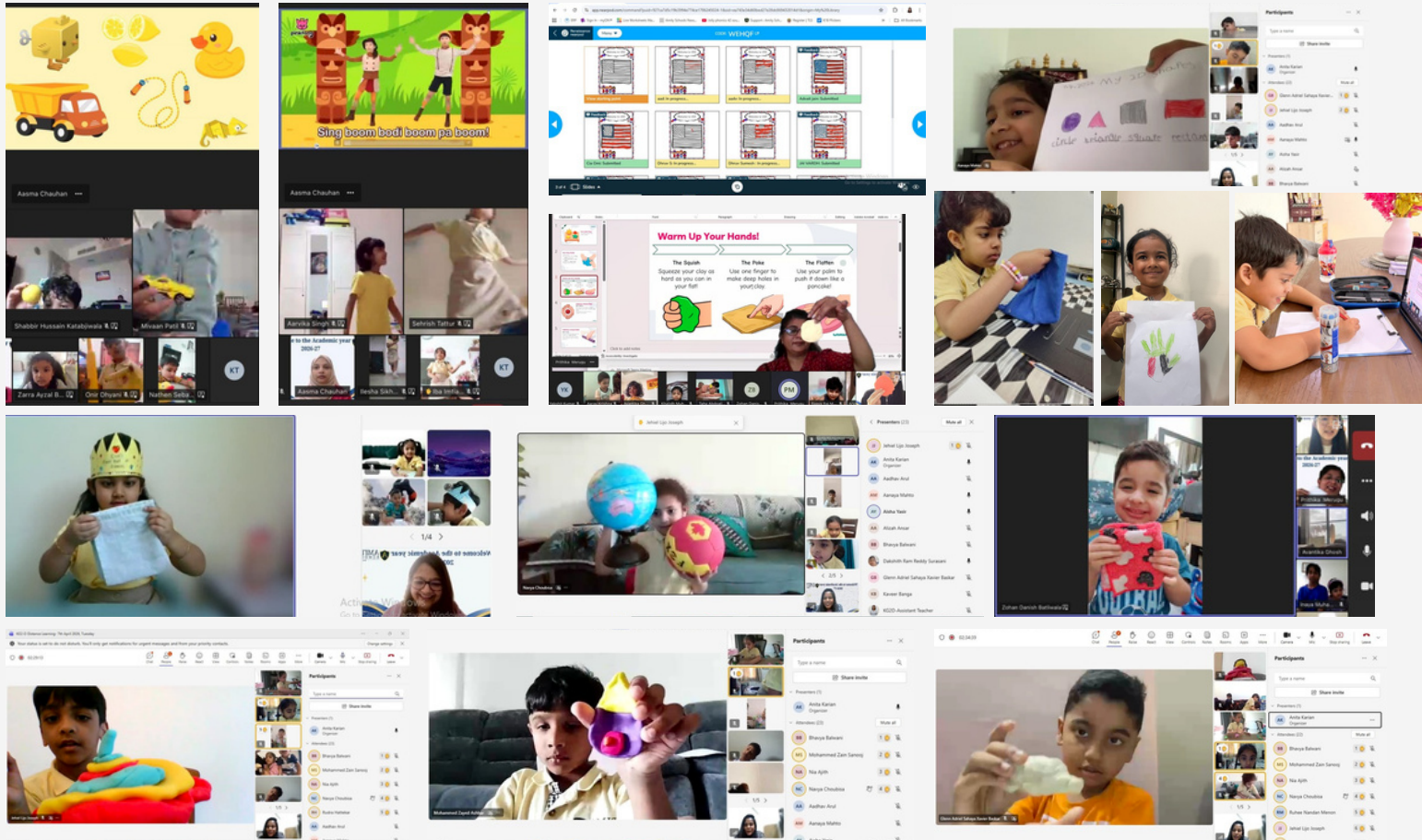

The first week of the new academic year was filled with laughter, learning, and lots of fun!

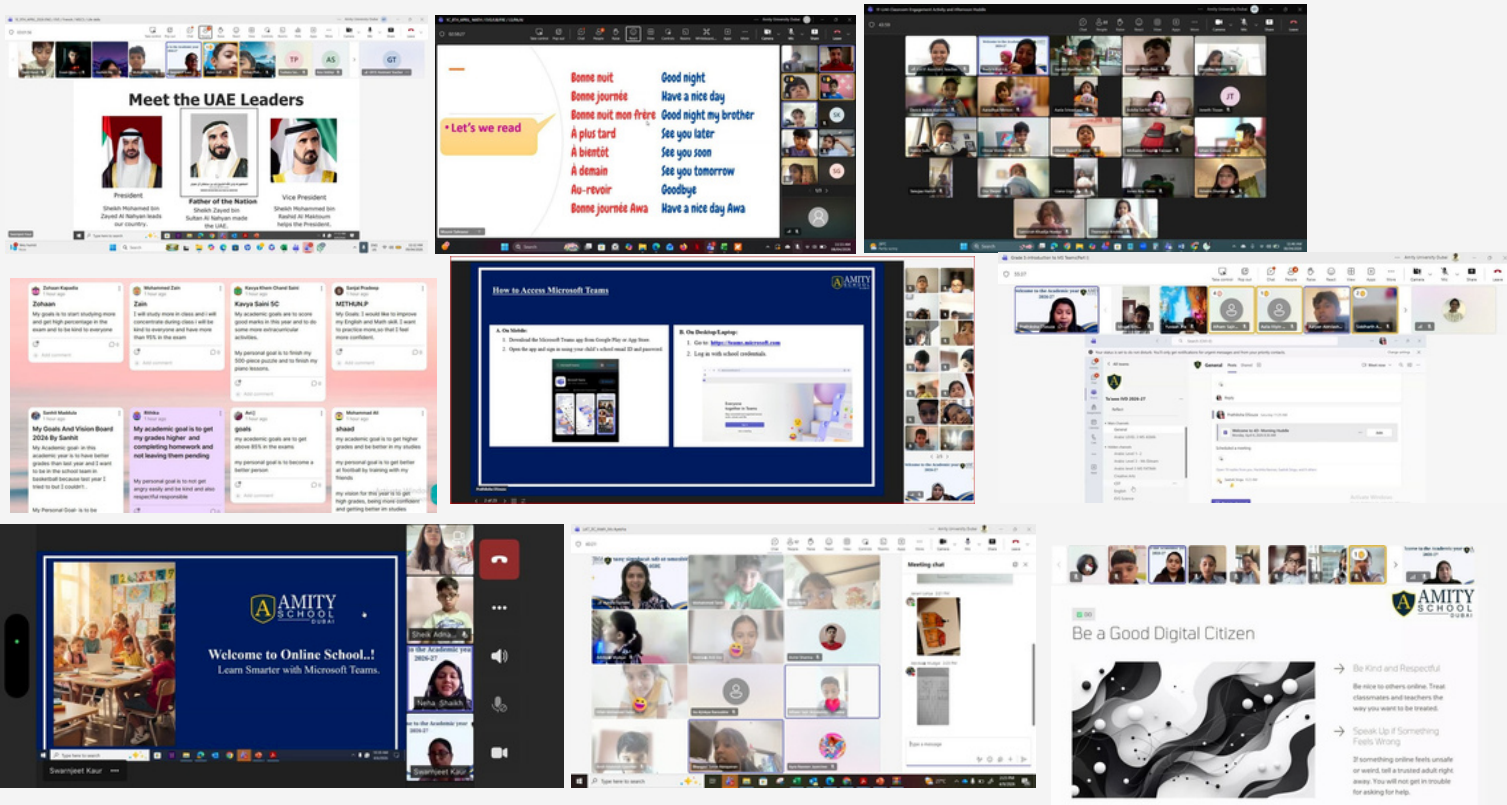
Our youngest learners, from Pre-K to KG2, jumped into activities designed to spark creativity and curiosity.

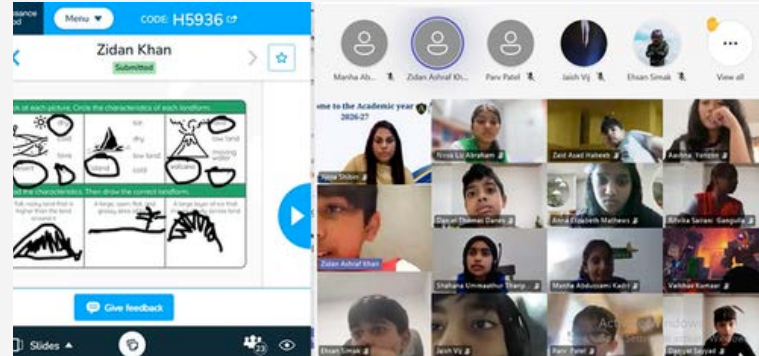

New Beginning for Ta'sees 6-8

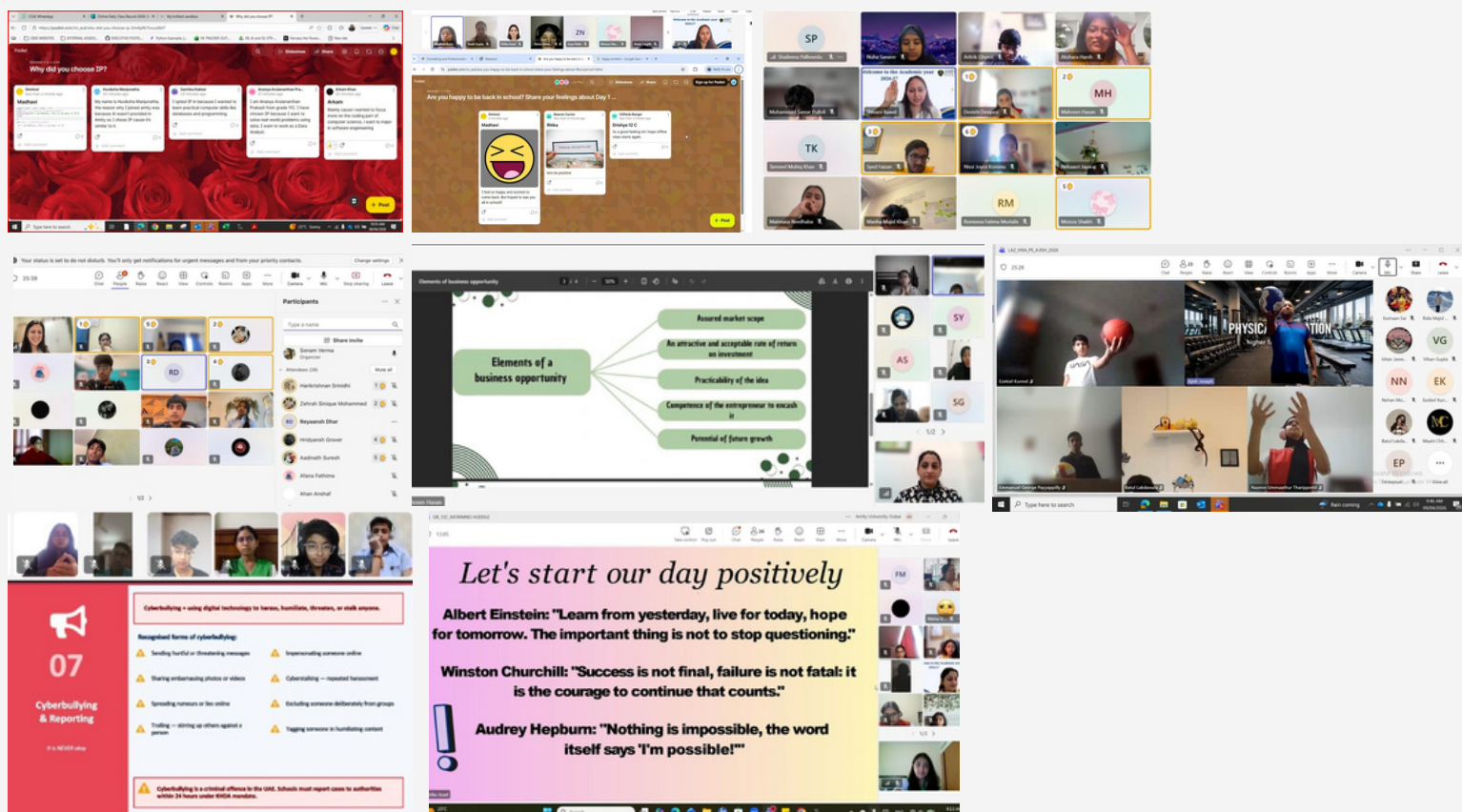
