Welcome Back



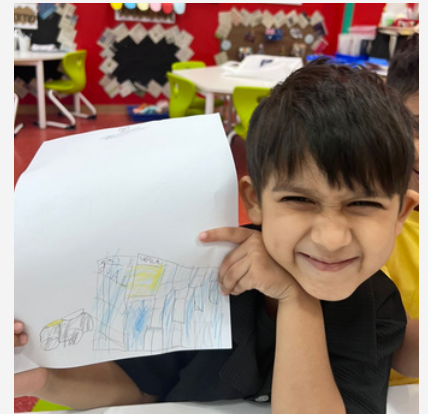
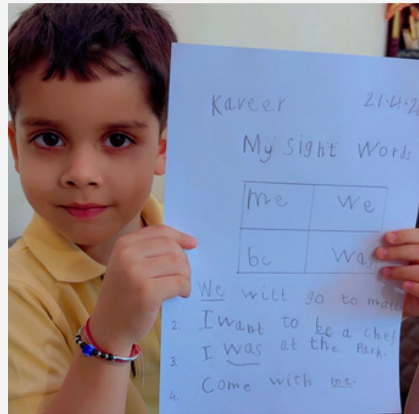

Be Brave, Be Kind

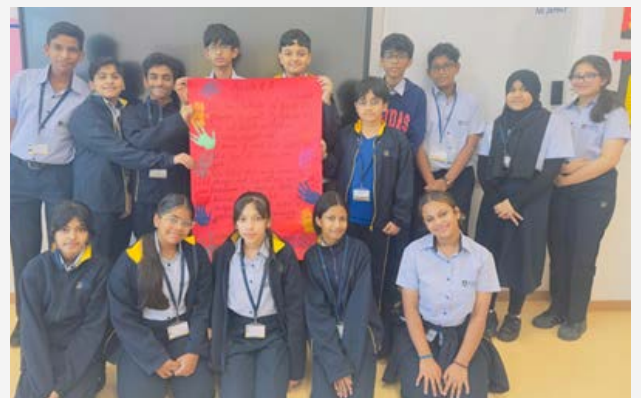
