Principal's Message



Term in Review: April–June 2026

As this term draws to a close, Amity School Dubai looks back on a period of steady academic growth and purposeful learning. Students transitioned confidently from remote beginnings in April to a fully engaged, in-person learning environment, demonstrating adaptability as a genuine learning skill in its own right. Our shift toward the CARE assessment culture, treating evaluation as a tool for growth rather than a verdict on performance, encouraged learners across Grades 3–8 to engage more deeply with feedback and self-reflection.

Wellbeing Wednesdays, and Thoughtful Thursdays built around the PERMA framework, strengthened resilience, decision-making, and emotional literacy alongside academic study, while the Achieve3000 and Rosen Level Up reading programmes sharpened comprehension and critical thinking from Kindergarten through Grade 9. Student achievement was evident across disciplines: from Al Nukhba scholars recognised for academic distinction, to competition wins in debate, commerce, robotics, and the arts.

The term ended on a truly memorable note with the Amity World Football Club, a Student Council-led tournament that turned the campus into a stadium of its own. Complete with team spirit, rivalry, and the raw disappointment of elimination, students experienced the highs and lows of a real-World Cup, a joyful reminder that learning happens in play as much as in the classroom.

As Nelson Mandela said, "Education is the most powerful weapon which you can use to change the world." This term, our students proved just how true that is.

The May and June top performers featured this week reflect the enthusiasm, dedication and steady progress our young learners demonstrate every day.

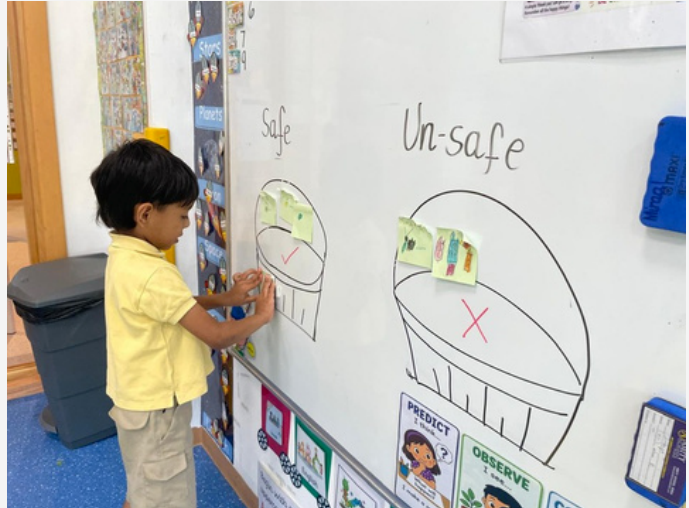

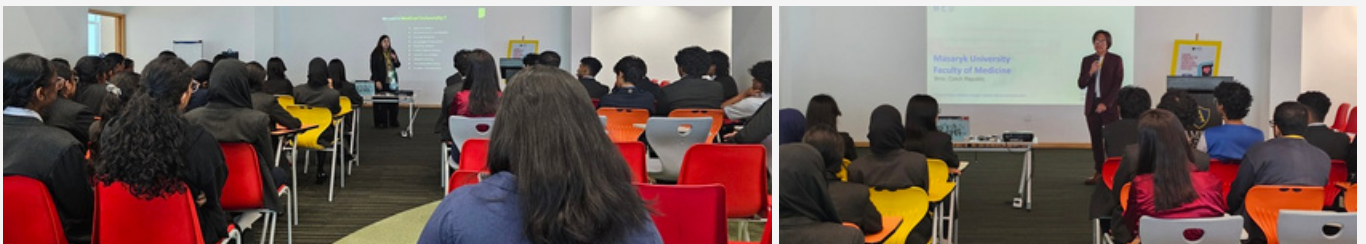
Celebrating Academic Excellence | CBSE Board Examination Awards Ceremony

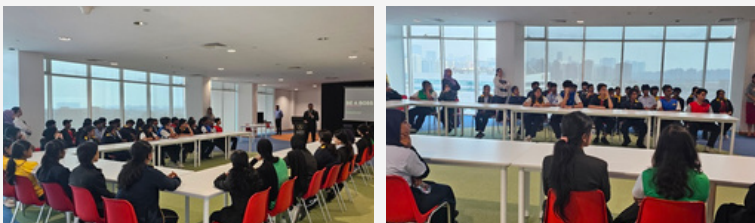
