Assessment as a Journey of Learning

As education continues to evolve, there is a growing recognition that true learning cannot be measured through a single examination at the end of a term. In line with CBSE's emphasis on competency-based learning and continuous progress, assessment today is increasingly viewed as a tool for learning rather than merely a measure of performance.

At Amity School Dubai, we strive to make assessment meaningful, supportive, and growth-oriented. Through our CARE (Continuous Assessment for Reinforcement and Excellence) programme for students of Grades 3 to 8 in English, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, and Hindi, along with Subject Enrichment Activities across grades, we provide students with regular opportunities to demonstrate their understanding, apply their learning, and receive constructive feedback.

These assessments help us identify strengths, address misconceptions at an early stage, and provide targeted support wherever needed. More importantly, they encourage students to view learning as a continuous process of improvement rather than preparation for a single high-stakes test. The detailed insights generated from these assessments enable teachers and parents to work together in supporting each child's academic growth and confidence.

As partners in your child's educational journey, I would like to assure you that our focus remains on nurturing deep understanding, critical thinking, and a love for learning. When assessment becomes an integral part of learning, it shifts the conversation from "How much did my child score?" to "What has my child learned, and what is the next step forward?" It is this culture of reflection, growth, and continuous improvement that we seek to foster in every classroom at Amity School Dubai.

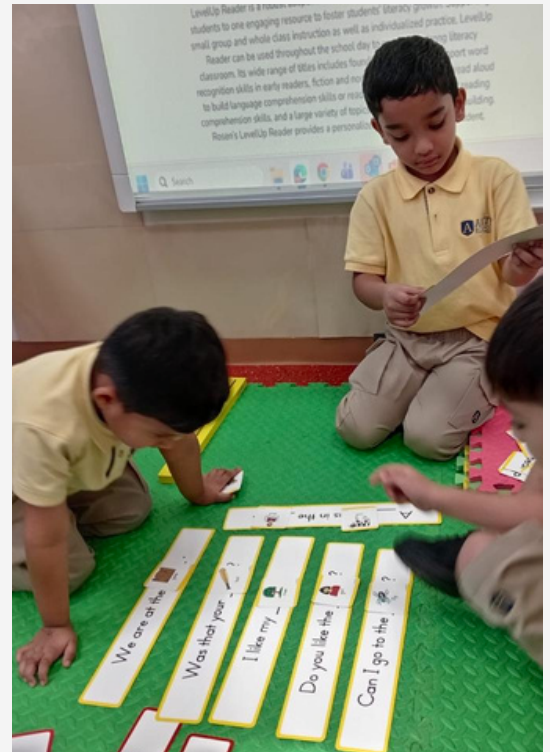
KG Assembly

In EVS, children discovered the parts of a plant and learned about their important functions through engaging activities and discussions.

Our K1 learners enjoyed a week full of exciting discoveries! In English, they explored the letter sound 'c' and practiced identifying words beginning with the sound. In Mathematics, children learned about the number 7 and identified numbers that come before. In EVS, they explored pet animals and their homes, developing an understanding of how animals are cared for and where they live.



Exploring the Wild Through Play

Our Pre-K learners explored the exciting world of wild animals in EVS, learning about where they live and how they survive. In English, they revised the 's' sound through fun words and activities. In Mathematics, children confidently revised numbers 1, 2, and 3 through hands-on counting and engaging classroom activities.



Wellbeing Wednesday: Positive Hearts, Safe Choices

Grades 1 and 2 explored “Try, Try Again” through the PERMA Model, learning how positive emotions help them try with patience and confidence. Grades 3 to 5 focused on “Safe and Unsafe Substances,” understanding simple safety rules, responsible choices, and the importance of reaching out to a trusted adult.

Overall, the week reflected joyful learning, emotional awareness, creativity, responsible choices, and language appreciation across the Primary section.



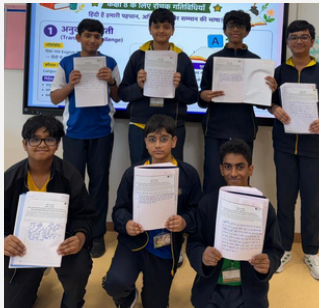
A Week of Language, Learning, and Safety Awareness
