Stepping into the Future: Career Day Celebration

Progress and enthusiasm



This week was filled with exploration and meaningful learning across all classes. Our Pre-K learners tuned into environmental sounds, strengthened fine motor skills through engaging sponge-squeezing activities, and delighted in reciting the rhyme “Jack and Jill”.

In K1, students explored triangles in math, practised writing and the letter sound “a,” recognized the number 3, and learned about body parts and their functions in EVS. K2 learners investigated natural and man-made materials, enhanced their English skills through words and sentences, and revisited 2D shapes in math.

Nurturing Wellness & Thoughtful Minds



During the Wellness session, students explored Relationships through the PERMAH model, focusing on conflict resolution and respectful communication. In Thoughtful Sessions, they learned about bullying with the theme “Stop, Walk, and Talk.” Students practiced how to respond appropriately by saying stop, walking away, and seeking help from a trusted adult. This helped build confidence, empathy, and positive social skills.

Handling Conflicts the Right Way

Wellbeing Wednesday centred on conflict resolution. Students engaged in discussions to understand how to manage disagreements calmly, listen to others, and work towards fair solutions, helping them build respectful and positive relationships.

We are proud to celebrate the achievements of our young learners in the NOF Olympiads.

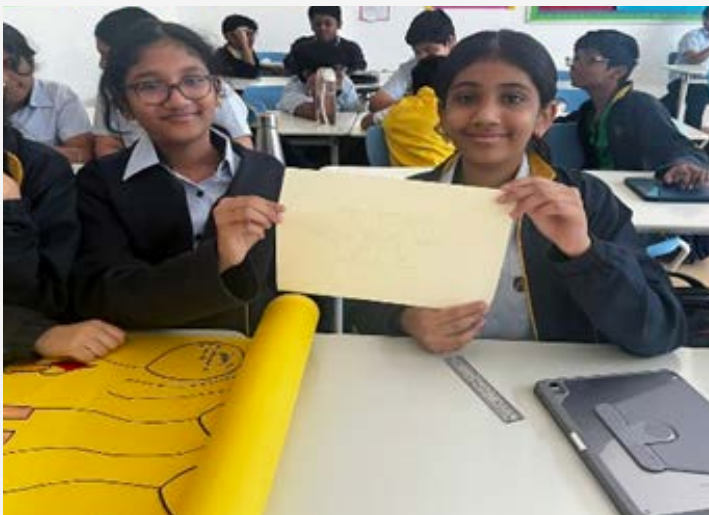
